# ZELENSKY: STOP DELAYS AND LET US FIRE MISSILES INTO RUSSIA

THE president of Ukraine yesterday furiously demanded permission to fire British missiles into Russian territory.

As Sir Keir Starmer and Joe Biden held talks in the White House last night,

Volodymyr Zelensky blasted the West's dithering while Russian forces 'burn down our cities and villages'.

It comes amid fears of a wider conflict, with Moscow warning the UN that a green light for

Kyiv to use long-range missiles to attack Russian territory would mean 'Nato will be a direct party to hostilities against a nuclear power'.

Tensions between Britain and Russia are on a knife-edge after the Kremlin expelled UK diplomats from Moscow.
